## NOTICE

This is for the information of all concerned that the **ADMIT CARD** for the D.Pharm Supplementary Examination, 2024 for **Part I & Part II candidates of ER 2020 and ER 1991 syllabus** is available for download in the online examination portal <u>www.osbp.in</u>.

The Principal/HODs of the affiliated colleges are requested to circulate the information among all the eligible candidates of their college who have filled-up the online examination forms to appear the said examination, facilitate the download and issue the admit card to the candidates.

## They are to ensure the following:

- 1. At the time the candidate takes delivery of the Admit Card, the Principal must ensure that it belongs to the particular candidate only.
- 2. That all details, Part and Subjects printed are correct.
- 3. Before handing-over to the candidate, the Admit Card in color print has to be signed with date and office seal by the Principal of the D.Pharm college.
- 4. The Admit Card will not be considered as valid without the signature with date and office seal of the Principal.
- That, the candidates carry the Admit Card complete in all aspects and other documents (original Aadhaar card with photograph, OSBP registration card, college ID card etc.) to the Examination centre.
- 6. That, no candidate will be allowed inside the examination hall without proper frisking and the required valid documents. No candidate will be allowed entry inside the examination hall once the examination starts.
- 7. The issue of the Admit Card is subject to the candidate fulfilling the eligibility criteria of the examination.
- 8. It is obligatory for the candidate to retain the Admit Card and produce it before the concerned authority whenever required.

Further communication regarding the matters related to the examination shall be made directly to the Principal/HODs of affiliated colleges through e-mail only by Odisha State Board of Pharmacy, Bhubaneswar.

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## IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE CANDIDATES

- 1. At the time of taking delivery of the Admit Card, the candidate **must ensure** that it is his/her and also ensure that all **details and subjects** printed are correct.
- 2. The Admit Card must be signed by the Principal of the college.
- 3. The Admit Card is issued subject to the candidate fulfilling the eligibility criteria of the examination.
- 4. It is obligatory for the candidate to retain this card and produce it before the concerned authority whenever required.
- 5. Candidates are advised to **verify the location of the examination centre** a day in advance so that they do not face any problem on the day of the examination.
- 6. Request for change of examination centre will not be entertained.
- 7. The candidate **must report at the examination center by 09:00 AM** i.e. one hour before commencement of exam.
- 8. The examination timings are from 10:00 AM to 01:00 PM.
- 9. The candidates will be allowed inside the examination hall at 9:45 AM.
- 10. No candidate will be allowed entry inside the examination hall once the examination starts.
- 11. No candidate will be allowed inside the examination hall without Original Admit card, Original valid ID proof issued by Govt. (Aadhaar Card with photograph in original) and proper frisking.
- 12. Photocopies of ID even if attested/scanned photo of ID in mobile phone will not be considered as valid ID proof.
- 13. Candidate must have and will be permitted to carry only the following items inside the examination hall Original Admit Card, OSBP Registration Card, valid ID proof/Aadhar Card, College ID Card.
- 14. One personal transparent water bottle, simple pen(s), pencil, simple geometry box are allowed inside the examination hall.
- 15. Candidates are NOT allowed to carry handbag, purse, any kind of paper/textual material (printed or written), Eatables (loose or packed), mobile phone/ear-phone/airpods/earpods/microphone, pager, calculator, DocuPen, pen drive, slide rules, camera, voice/video recorder, to wear/carry smart watch/electronic watch/calculator, any metallic item, electronic gadgets/ devices to the examination hall/room. Possession and/or use of any of the above items will lead to action as deemed proper as per rules.
- 16. Examination officials **will not be responsible** for safe keep of the belongings and there may be no facility for this at the centre.
- 17. The candidate **should not adopt unfair means** or indulge in unfair examination practices, impersonation etc. Any candidates found using unfair means are liable for strict action as deemed proper as per rules.
- 18. If at any stage it is found the candidate has used unfair means, his/her candidature will be cancelled and action deemed proper will be taken.
- 19. The candidates should **avoid bio-breaks** during the first one hour after beginning of the examination and last half hour of the examination.
- 20. Candidates are **not allowed to leave** the examination hall before an hour after the examination starts. Before leaving the examination hall the candidate must take permission of the invigilator and submit the answer book. No candidate will be allowed re-entry once he/she has permanently submitted the answer book.
- 21. Candidates are not permitted to talk to each other inside the examination hall.
- 22. Candidate should not write anything on the question paper except his Roll No.
- 23. The candidate should not tear, disfigure, mutilate the answer book.
- 24. No additional sheet will be provided to ER 2020 candidates.
- 25. Answer books containing **information other than the answers** (e.g. mobile number/symbols not relevant to the answers/pleading/requests to evaluator etc.) will be **treated as MAL-PRACTICE.**

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
